His Legacy... Robert Oscar Wahr, Age 90, passed away November 23, 2019. He was born on August 13, 1929, at home in Norvell Township, the son of Oscar and Amelia (Fox) Wahr. Bob married the love of his life, Beverly Reed, on July 11, 1959 at the Brooklyn Presbyterian Church. Bob served honorably in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict where he was stationed in Germany as a Military Policeman. After his service to our country he returned to Brooklyn where he worked at the Brooklyn Ford Plant. After that plant closed he was transferred to the Saline Ford Plant retiring after 31 years in 1979. Bob was not one to sit around long when his friend asked him to help with carpentry, of which he retired from after 20 years.
