**R**aymond Lee Webb, 66, passed away December 12, 2021, at home with his family present. Ray's family and friends will gather on Thursday, December 16, 2021, from 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. at Eineder Funeral Homes - Brooklyn Chapel. 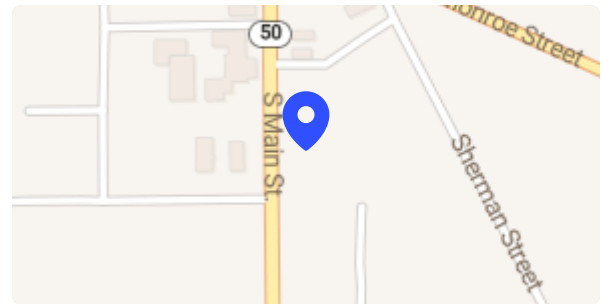

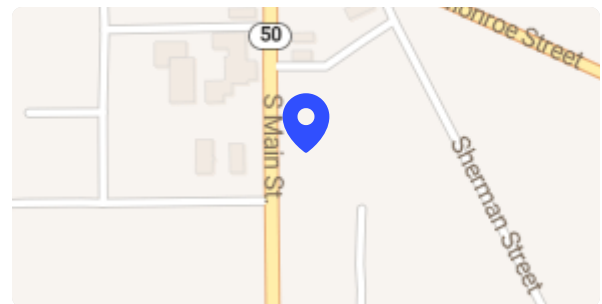
