Age 87, of Wolf Lake, passed away September 19, 2018 at the Henry Ford Allegiance Hospice Home. He is survived by his wife of 41 years, Sharon; four children, John (Pam), James (Marilyn), and Paula Kujawa, and Kelly (Marc) Settineri; six grandchildren, Janelle (Dean) Hoopes, Jordan and Kyle Kujawa, Alexis, Joe and Melina Settineri; sister-in-law, Joyce Hickory and nephews, William Tenuta, Todd and Kirk Hickory.
