Deborah Frances Lang, 68, of Brooklyn, passed away on January 17, 2024, at Toledo Hospital in Ohio. Debbie's family and friends will gather on Tuesday, January 23, 2024, from 3:00PM- 7:00PM at Eineder Funeral Homes - Brooklyn Chapel with a Rosary at 6:30PM. Her Mass of Christian burial will be held at St. Joseph Shrine Catholic Church on Wednesday, January 24, 2024, following the gathering from 10:00AM- 11:00AM. Her burial will follow at St. Joseph Shrine Catholic Cemetery. Father Zach Mabee will serve as celebrant.

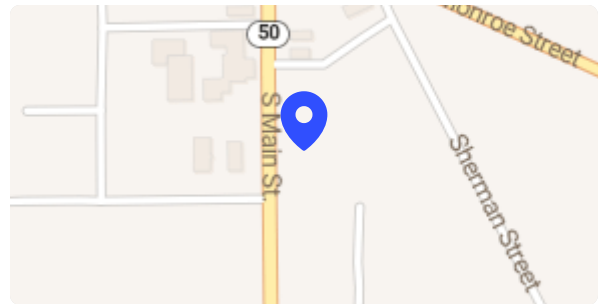

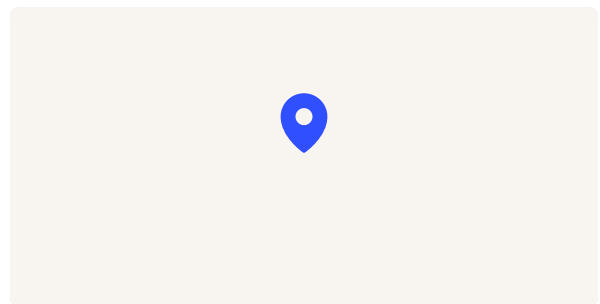

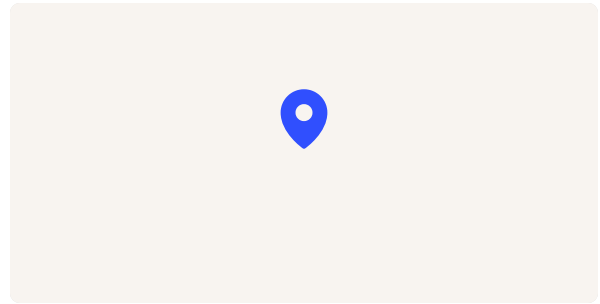
