Patrick Boylan, 73, of Brooklyn passed away at home Wednesday, January 1, 2025. Pat's family and friends will gather Monday, January 6, 2025 from 4:00 pm – 7:00 pm at Eineder Funeral Homes – Brooklyn Chapel. His funeral service will be held at 11:00 am following visitation from 10:00 am – 11:00 am, on Tuesday, January 7, 2025 at Eineder Funeral Homes – Brooklyn Chapel. Pastor Jim Morrison from Jackson Summit Church of God will officiate.

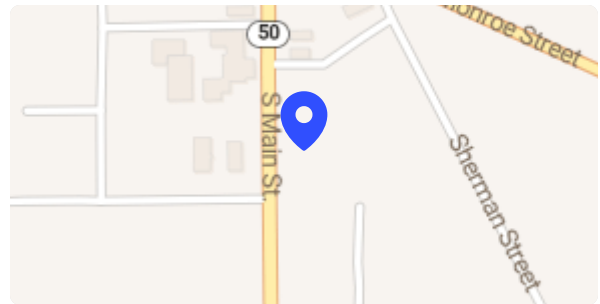

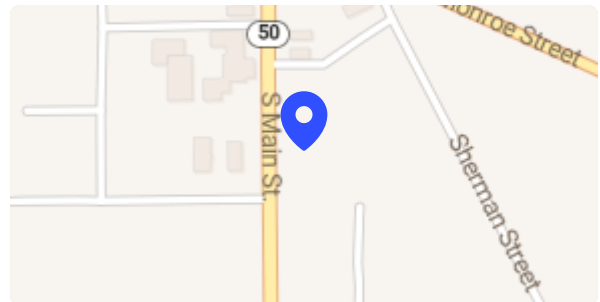

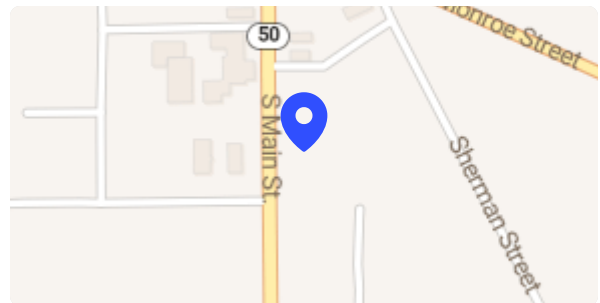
