Glenn “Ed” Hoffman, 90 , of Jackson, Michigan, passed away at Henry Ford-Jackson hospital, November 18, 2025. Glenn’s Funeral Mass will be held at 11:00 a.m., Friday, December 19, 2025 at St. Rita Catholic Church 10516 Hayes Rd., Clark Lake, Michigan. Fr. Bosco Padamattummal will officiate. A luncheon will follow after the Mass.

Ed was born on August 7, 1935, in Detroit, Michigan to Alexander and Rose (Etlinger) Hoffman. 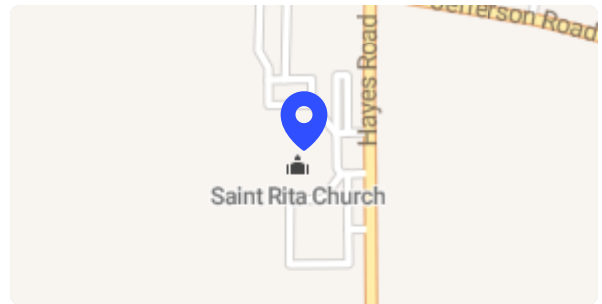
