**R**aymond Joseph Poremba, age 76, of Brooklyn, MI, passed away on April 16, 2026 surrounded by family and loved ones.

He was born on March 8, 1950 in Detroit, MI to Joseph and Agnes Poremba. He graduated high school from Sacred Heart Seminary in Detroit in 1968. He then attended Henry Ford Community College where he met Bonnie Turner when he was 18 years old. On August 22, 1969, they were married.

Ray earned an undergraduate degree from the U of M Dearborn and a master's degree from Wayne State University. He retired from a career at Ford Motor Company in 2003. His career began working the assembly line at Woodhaven Stamping Plant. He went on to work primarily in Labor Relations and Human Resources. 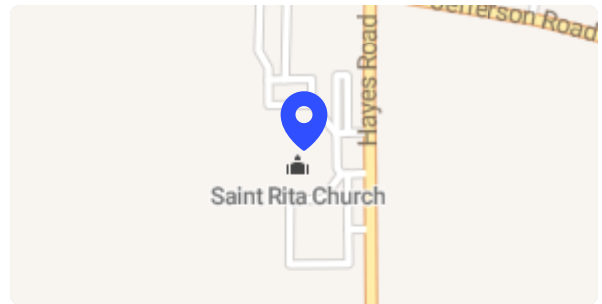
